

## RIETVELD SCHRÖDER HOUSE - TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF IMAGE USE

1. The Rietveld Schröder House is operated by the Centraal Museum. The use of images of Rietveld Schröder House is therefore subject to the same terms and conditions as apply at the Centraal Museum.

- 1. Press images supplied by the museum may only be used as supporting illustrations in discussions about the connected activity, etc. at the Centraal Museum.
- 2. Press images of exhibitions may be used for the duration of the exhibition only, and only as described under item 1 above.
- 3. When using an image, the collection must always be credited; the full credit is preferred.
- 4. The photographer's name, if supplied by the museum, must also be credited.
- 5. Images are made available by the museum under the stated terms and conditions. Artworks made by artists who have been dead for less than 70 years may still be under copyright to a person or entity other than the museum. In that case, you must obtain permission from the copyright holder before publishing and/or reproducing the images supplied by the museum. Most copyright holders are represented by Pictoright in Amsterdam.
- 6. Duplication and commercial use of images supplied by the museum are not permitted. You can request images for these purposes from the museum's Visual Documentation Department. Click here for more information.
- 7. The museum takes every precaution when compiling its materials and accepts no responsibility or liability for any damage to hardware or software in connection with the downloading of materials from its website.
- 8. The museum reserves the right to amend these terms and conditions.
